**TELL THE TRUTH.

Afoot is a deceptively simple deduction race for 2 to 5 sleuths.

Players are tasked with one simple challenge: be the first player to correctly name the facedown culprit.

There are only thirteen suspects, matching the cards from a single suit of common playing cards (2 to Ace).

Players only get one chance to risk it all and name the culprit, so they must be careful. Not only must they be correct, they must also be quicker than the competition.

Each player starts with private suspects in hand and must travel around London following leads to learn more about the suspects known to other players.

Players ask other players YES/NO questions, which can range from very simple to very intricate. Get creative!

- “Do you have the Queen suspect?”
- “Do you have exactly two odd numbered suspects?”
- “Do you have any suspects with leads on their location?”
- “Have you used your player power to lie this game?”

Players must be careful, as their questions often betray what information they hold.

SIMPLE PLAYER TURNS:

- 1- Move to adjacent location.
 - Ask a YES/NO question.
- 2- Strongarm a lead in London.
 - Explore a London Landmark.

- ! Slap the facedown culprit! Risk it all to win or lose!

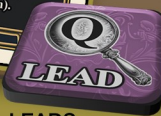
